### MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT

#### Snow Smarts

Improperly placing snow on or near a public road creates hazards including drainage problems, drifting, sight obstruction, unsafe access, slippery areas, frozen ruts or bumps that may contribute to a motor vehicle or pedestrian crash. The Ontario Highway Traffic Act, Sec. 181. States that "No person shall deposit snow or ice on a roadway without permission in writing so to do, from the Ministry or the road authority responsible for the maintenance of the road." R.S.O. 1990, c. H.8, s. 181. **Plowing, blowing, shoveling or otherwise placing of snow onto a Municipal road is not permitted within the Township of South Stormont.**

#### Quarterly Utility (Water/Sewer) Billing

Water meters have been estimated for October, November and December, 2015. Estimates are based on account history and are forthcoming. The next on-site reading will be done in March-April.
