Reduced Load Period

There may be a requirement to implement the load restriction period prior to March 1 of this year. This is necessary for the protection of roads and highways due to spring thaw conditions. Please check our website, watch our facebook posts for any updates or changes or contact the Town Hall during regular working hours.

Landfill Pass

Landfill passes are now available for 2016. This will allow two free loads to the landfill site. The free loads do not include construction material, rimmed tires or appliances containing freon. Landfill passes can be picked up at the Town Hall (if you still have your old landfill pass please bring it to the office) or mailed upon request.

FINANCE

Quarterly Utility (Water/Sewer) Billing

Water meters have been estimated for October, November and December, 2015. Estimates are based on account history and are due February 22, 2016. The next on-site reading will be done in March-April. Property owners are reminded that any outstanding balances will be transferred to taxes after the due date and will be included on your interim tax bill. Your water/sewer bill can now be delivered by e-mail. Please visit the Township office or our website www.southstormont.ca to fill out an application and send it to kandie@southstormont.ca or drop it off at the Town Hall.

Property Tax Billing

Interim tax bills are anticipated to be mailed out in early March and due March 31. For your information, please be advised of the following methods of payment available:

- In person at the Town Hall, cash, cheque, debit, post-dated cheques.
- Mail cheque or money order to P.O. Box 84, Long Sault, ON K0C 1P0.
- After hours, access the drop off box beside the front entrance of the Town Hall.
- Telephone/internet banking.
- At ABMs (automated bank machines) and at most financial institutions.

Please ensure that your method of payment allows sufficient time for processing; payments must be received at the office by the due date. For your information a penalty of 1.25% is added to all outstanding tax accounts the day after the payment due date and continues to be added on the first day of each month until the account is paid in full. Thank you for your cooperation. Should you have any questions, please contact the Town Hall.

FIRE & RESCUE

- **DEVELOP** a home fire escape plan today...it could save your life tonight!

MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT

By-law No. 2011-082 prohibits the operation of vehicles on municipally owned property intended for park use. ATV's, UTV's, side-by-sides and dirt bikes are not permitted to use parkland or pathways to parks as a throughway to the trails or municipal roads. Parks and pathways are intended for pedestrian use only. Municipal roads, including sidewalks south of Highway 401 are off limits to Off Road Vehicles (ORV) such as, ATV's, UTV's and side-by-sides. Operators must transport ORVs on a truck or trailer to access the trail system. Operators may be subject to a fine if observed operating one of these vehicles in a park, pathway, municipal road or sidewalk.
