HYDRANT FLUSHING NOTICE

Hydrant flushing will be carried out from October 1 – November 2 in the hamlets of Ingleside, Long Sault and St. Andrews West. During the flushing operation, poor water pressure and/or red water may occur. This situation is temporary and may last up to two hours, however the coloured water is not hazardous. If coloured water is detected, it is suggested residents open their COLD water taps to clear the system.

2018 FINAL PROPERTY TAX BILLS

As a friendly reminder, the final tax installment for 2018 is due September 28th. Should you have any questions concerning your bill or if you have not received your bill, please contact the Municipal Office. Payments may be made by online/telephone banking, pre-authorized payments, mail, in person or via the drop box situated outside the main door of the Municipal Office. Please note that payments must be received by the due date to ensure no penalty will be applied. Due to a potential postal strike in October, residents are encouraged to take steps to ensure payments are received prior to the due date to avoid penalties. A post-dated cheque may be submitted or mailed at any time to ensure payment is received on time. Residents are also encouraged to utilize other methods of payment such as online/telephone banking or pre authorized payment options which are available on a monthly or instalment basis for both Property Tax payments and Water and Sewer payments. Online/Telephone Banking Notice: In order to avoid penalties on your Property account or your Water/Sewer (Utility) account, please ensure to select the right payee from your bank list as well as the roll number provided on the respective billing when making online or telephone payments.

VOTER INFORMATION LETTER - IMPORTANT NOTICE

Keep an eye out! Voter Information Letters are on their way! There may be a work stoppage at Canada Post. To avoid delays, Voter Information Letters will be mailed out early to all eligible and registered electors. The Voter Information Letters will be mailed in a white envelope with: **IMPORTANT INFORMATION: 2018 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS** printed on the front. This letter will contain your individual, confidential Voting PIN and will include instructions on how to access the online voting system. Please keep this letter in a safe place as you will need it to cast your ballot in the Municipal Elections in October.



VOTERS' LIST

To have your name added to the Voters' List, eligible electors are asked to contact Town Hall by calling 613-534-8889 or by sending an email to either info@southstormont.ca or vote@southstormont.ca to request an Application to Amend the Voters List (Form 24). The form must be completed and brought to Town Hall where the elector must show proof of name and qualifying address. Ontario Regulation 304/13 requires that identification must be an original, certified or notarial copy and shall show the person's name and qualifying address. Visit our website for a full list of acceptable identification.

ELECTION INFORMATION OPEN HOUSE

The Township of South Stormont will be hosting an Election Information Open House on **October 2 from 4 PM to 7 PM at the South Stormont Town Hall (2 Mille Roches Road, Long Sault). Residents are welcome to ask questions regarding the Voters' List, voting location or other election procedures. Eligible electors will also be able to confirm their information on the Voters' List is correct.**

FIRE AND RESCUE

ALARMED FOR LIFE!

Starting this September, Fire Fighters from South Stormont Fire and Rescue will be conducting a door to door smoke and carbon monoxide (CO) alarm campaign called "Alarmed for Life". If a Fire Fighter knocks on your door, please take a few minutes to answer some simple questions about smoke and CO alarms in your home. We will also answer any questions you have about smoke and CO alarms, and general fire safety. During this program, no fines or charges will be issued. A few key points to remember when it comes to smoke and CO alarms:

- Smoke alarms are required on every level and outside of every bedroom
- CO alarms are ONLY required outside of sleeping areas
- Smoke and CO alarms have expiry dates. Please check and ensure they are replaced accordingly
- Test your alarms at least once a month to ensure they are working
- Replace batteries in your alarms at least once a year

MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT

Fire Access Routes have been designated in front of the Long Sault Plaza (from Plaza Drive to the east end of the Pharmacy) and the Ingleside Plaza (from Bank St to Fines Home Hardware). You can stop to let people out of the vehicle but you have to leave immediately. You can stop to let people get into the vehicle but you can't wait for them there and you have to leave immediately. Any non-emergency vehicle parked in a fire access route may be issued a \$50.00 fine.
