**BY-LAW ENFORCEMENT**

**ABANDONED AND UN-PLATED VEHICLES**

**BY-LAW No. 2004-86**

No vehicle in a wrecked, discarded, dismantled or inoperative condition or is unlicensed shall be parked, stored, or left in the yard unless such vehicle is required for business or farming purposes and then only in an arrangement such as to prevent an unsafe or unsightly condition.

**Did you know, careless smoking is the leading cause of fire deaths in Ontario? Here are tips to avoid careless smoking in your home.**

- Encourage smokers to smoke outside.
- Use large, deep ashtrays that can't be knocked over.
- Empty ashes into a metal container and place it outside.
- Install smoke alarms on every storey and outside sleeping areas.
- Test your smoke alarms every month and replace the batteries at least once per year.

**BUILDING**

In addition to the requirements of the Ontario Building Code Act (OBC), remember that there are restrictions, such as maximum height, lot coverage and setbacks to property lines that you need to take into consideration before applying for a building permit. Even if a permit is not required under the OBC, these restrictions apply. Please contact the Township early in the planning stages to ensure that your project meets any requirements under the Municipal Zoning By-law.

**HYDRANT FLUSHING AND MAINTENANCE PROGRAM**

From **June 15 - August 31, 2017** in the hamlets of Ingleside, Long Sault and St. Andrews West.

- During testing, poor water pressure and/or RED water may result.
- This is temporary and may last up to two hours.
- The coloured water is not hazardous.
- If coloured water is detected, the public is requested to open their COLD water taps in order to clear the system.
