- Each following offence: \$1,000 to \$4,000, six demerit points and possible jail time (up to six months).

**BY-LAW ENFORCEMENT**

Shipping containers and storage containers shall only be permitted in Industrial Zones (ML, MM, MH, MR) and the Highway Commercial Zone (CH). They shall be in accordance with Site Plan Control and the restrictions stated in section 3.34 and defined in Section 2 of By-law 2011-100 (Zoning By-law).
