Are you ready? Online Voting and Advance Polls are now open!

**WHEN CAN I VOTE?** Online voting will commence on October 17, 2018 at 9:00 am and conclude on October 22, 2018 at 8:00 pm. You will require your Voter Information Letter to vote.

For those individuals who prefer to vote by paper ballot, or who require the assistance of a trained Election Official, an advance Voting Place and several Election Day Voting Places will be open to provide in-person voting opportunities. Please note you must bring your Voter Information Letter and identification when voting in person.
