Changes To Water Meter Readings

Quarterly water billings have been based on three actual meter readings (April, July, October) and one estimate (January) per year. In an effort to improve efficiencies, there will be four actual meter readings per year beginning December 1, 2018 and continuing every three months thereafter. The December 1, 2018 reading will be for a two month period (October & November). Your minimum water bill, **for this period ONLY**, will be based on usage of 25.66 cubic meters or less and your minimum amount payable will be reduced accordingly. Utility bills will be mailed out the first week of January, 2019.

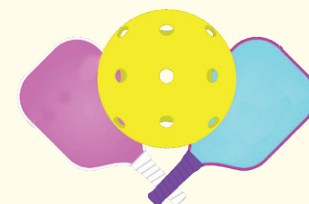
