Subject: RFQ No. 19-2018 IT Managed Services

Recommendation:

That Council award RFQ No. 19-2018 for IT Managed Services to Optimus Tech Solutions in the amount of \$42,000 for transition project work and \$3,925 thereafter for monthly licensing, back up and monitoring costs as included in the 2019 proposed budget.

Further, that the Director of Corporate Services/Clerk be authorized to sign the necessary documentation.

Background:

In December, 2018 the Township issued an RFQ seeking Information Technology specialists for support services in cloud backup, network management and security monitoring.

The issuance of the RFQ came as a recommendation of the IT Master Plan completed in 2018 that identified areas of required improvement. The plan was developed to move critical workloads to the cloud in addition to enhanced security, such as cloud access security broker, security information and event management technologies.

Two submissions were received and are summarized in the following page. Based on staff's review in addition to a recommendation from Gary Walker, Perry Group, it is recommended to award the RFQ to Optimus Tech Solutions.

Although slightly higher in price Optimus is a Microsoft partner, which will continue to be beneficial as the Township moves forward with a cloud based approach. In addition, Optimus has been involved with Township security and improvements over the last 6 months implementing measures that were urgent in nature. As such they are familiar with the Township's current IT status.

The Optimus quote includes costs to move servers into Azure, which is one of the recommendations of the Master Plan.
