Passing of Procedural By-law – Council Meeting Time Change

Council of the Township of South Stormont has passed a new Procedural By-law on March 27, 2019.

This is the by-law that regulates how we do business and how meetings are conducted. One significant change to Council Meetings through this by-law is a new start time for Regular Council Meetings, which will now begin at 5:00 PM. You can review the new by-law in its entirety at southstormont.ca

Hydrant Flushing

Hydrant flushing will be carried out from April 29-May31, 2019 in the hamlets of Ingleside, Long Sault and St. Andrews West.

- During the flushing operation, poor water pressure and/or RED water may result
- This situation is temporary and may last up to two hours
- The coloured water is not hazardous
- If coloured water is detected, the public is requested to open their COLD water taps in order to clear the system

Sunset Drive Re-Alignment Partial Road Closure

Sunset Drive has been re-aligned creating a safer intersection where it intersects with Moulinette Island Causeway. This was done as part of construction already taking place on Moulinette Island. As a result, Parts 1, 2 and 3 on 52R-8201 are no longer necessary as part of the Township's road network and therefore, it is appropriate to close and sell properties to adjacent landowners.

Pursuant to the Township's Policy to Close and Sell a Road, Council of the Township of South Stormont will declare the following as surplus and hereby gives notice of their intention to permanently close the following:

- Parts 1, 2 and 3 on Reference Plan 52R-8201, Part of Plan 294, Part of PIN 60223-0161, geographic Township of Cornwall, Township of South Stormont, County of Stormont.

Should you wish to make a submission, either in favour of or in opposition please forward comments to the Director of Corporate Services/Clerk at PO Box 84, Long Sault, ON K0C 1P0 or via email at loriann@southstormont.ca prior to May 1, 2019. Following consideration of comments received, Council will consider the necessary by-law on May 8, 2019 or on a subsequent meeting date to permanently close the aforementioned road allowance.

By-law Enforcement

Dog Licensing and Control By-law No. 52-2004
Dogs must be on a leash at all time when on public property which includes parks and trails. This helps prevent injury to other park and trail users, including other dogs. Pet owners are also responsible for cleaning up after their pets, in an effort to keep our parks, trails and sidewalks clean.

Wildlife Complaints

-The Township of South Stormont Municipal Law Enforcement Officer does not have training on the handling of wildlife. Residents must contact a private wildlife control contractor at their own expense to deal with nuisance or injured wildlife.

Property Tax Billing

The interim tax bills were due March 29. A penalty of 1.25% is added to all outstanding tax accounts the day after the payment due date and continues to be added on the first day of each month until the account is paid in full. The Final property tax bill will be mailed in early June.

FIRE AND RESCUE - Emergency Preparedness Week May 5-11

Emergency Preparedness Week (EP Week) is an annual event that takes place each year during the first full week of May. If an emergency happens, it may take emergency workers some time to reach you. You should be prepared to take care of yourself and your family for a minimum of 72 hours.

Build an Emergency Survival Kit to survive for at least three days

- Bottled water - four litres of water per person per day
- Non-perishable food
- Manual can opener
- Flashlight(s) and extra batteries
- Battery-powered or wind-up radio
- First aid kit
- Special needs items such as medications, infant formula, equipment for people with disabilities, items for pets
- Extra keys to your car and house
- Cash
- Candles and matches/lighter
- A copy of your emergency plan and contact information, important papers (identification, contact list, etc.)
