HYDRANT FLUSHING AND MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

Hydrant flushing will be carried out from October 3 to November 3 in the hamlets of Ingleside, Long Sault and St. Andrews West

- During the flushing operation, poor water pressure and/or RED water may result
- This situation is temporary and may last up to two hours
- The coloured water is not hazardous
- If coloured water is detected, the public is requested to open their COLD water taps in order to clear the system

BY-LAW ENFORCEMENT

Only emergency vehicles are permitted to park in the fire access route. Fire Access Route means any road, driveway, ramp or other means of vehicular access or egress and shall conform to the requirements of the Ontario Fire Code Act and Regulations thereto, as amended. Any non-emergency vehicle parked in a fire access route will be issued a \$50.00 fine.

FIRE & RESCUE

Fire Prevention Week runs from October 8 to 14

In a fire, seconds count. Seconds can mean the difference between residents of our community escaping safely from a fire or having their lives end in tragedy. Here are some tips on how to plan your escape plan:

- Draw a map of your home with all members of your household, marking two exits from each room and a path to the outside from each exit.
- Practice your home fire drill twice a year. Conduct one at night and one during the day with everyone in your home, and practice using different ways out.
- Teach children how to escape on their own in case you can't help them.
- Once you get outside, stay outside. Never go back inside a burning building.
- Make sure to test your smoke alarms every month. If you would like a Home Safe Home inspection free of charge please call the Township office at 613-534-8889.
