Hydrant Flushing

Hydrant flushing will be carried out from until May 31, 2019 in the hamlets of Ingleside, Long Sault and St. Andrews West.

- During the flushing operation, poor water pressure and/or RED water may result

- The coloured water is not hazardous
- If coloured water is detected, the public is requested to open their COLD water taps in order to clear the system

FIRE AND RESCUE

Recreational Fires

Recreational fires are meant for cooking, heating or general enjoyment and do NOT require an Open Air Fire Permit, as long as the following conditions are met:

- In a non-combustible container no larger than 18" x 18" x 18"
- Burn between 8:00am – midnight only
- Burn clean, dry wood only
- Must be at least 5 metres from any building, tree or other combustible material.

Open Air Fires

There are 3 types of Open Air Fires, each requiring an Open Air Fire Permit:

- Fires no greater than 1 cubic metre
- Fires for normal farm/rural practice in height
- Fires for land clearing – windrows.

These types of fires are not permitted within any urban settlement area, as designated within the SDG County Official Plan. Other regulations apply, and you can view the entire Open Air Burn By-law on southstormont.ca

BY-LAW ENFORCEMENT

Clean Yards By-law

The Township of South Stormont now has a new By-law to regulate the care and maintenance of land. It addresses violations of 1) "Refuse" on property, 2) "Derelict Vehicles" on property and 3) grass that is not cut or maintained. Once Notice has been given, the By-law permits the Township to enter property and do the work to bring the property into compliance. The cost can then be billed to the owner or added to the property tax. Fines of \$150 may also apply. Go to the Township website to see the "Clean Yards By-law"
