Quarterly Utility Billing (Water/Sewer for the period July, August, September 2017)

Utility bills will be mailed by the end of October. Should you have any questions concerning your bill, or do not receive your bill, please contact Town Hall. Payments may be made by mail, online/telephone banking, pre-authorized payments, in person or via the drop box situated outside the front door of the Town Hall. Please note that payments must be received by the due date to ensure no penalty will be applied.

FIRE & RESCUE

Heating Safety:

Some simple steps can prevent most heating-related fires from happening:

- Keep anything that can burn at least three feet away from heating equipment like a furnace, fireplace, wood stove, or portable space heater
- Have a three-foot "kid-free zone" around open fires and space heaters
- Have a qualified professional install stationary space heating equipment, water heaters or central heating equipment according to the local codes and manufacturer's instructions
- Have heating equipment and chimneys cleaned and inspected every year by a qualified professional
- Remember to turn portable heaters off when leaving the room or going to bed
- Test smoke alarms at least once a month.
