- In person at the Town Hall, cash, cheque, debit, post-dated cheques
- At ABMs (automated bank machines) and at most financial institutions

For your information a penalty of 1.25% is added to all outstanding tax accounts the day after the payment due date and continues to be added on the first day of each month until the account is paid in full. **SOUTH STORMONT FIRE AND RESCUE**

**Spring Cleaning for Home Fire Safety**

South Stormont Fire and Rescue would like to encourage you to include home fire safety items on your spring cleaning checklist.

- Check your smoke and carbon monoxide alarms. You should test your alarms every month by pressing the TEST button, and replace the batteries at least once a year. If your alarm is more than 10 years old, replace it.
- In the laundry room, clean out your dryer filter, vents, and hoses of any lint and debris. Keeping the lint filters clean after each load will reduce the chance of a dryer fire.
- Check your home for cracked, frayed, or overloaded extension cords or surge protectors. Make sure appliances are plugged into wall outlets, instead of extension cords. Remove any cords that run under rugs, or can be pinched by doors and furniture. These can spark and cause a fire.
- Ensure you have an Emergency Survival Kit in case of incidents such as power outages and flooding. A list of items that should be included in an Emergency Survival Kit can be found on our website.
- Practice your home escape plan. Discuss the escape routes with every member of your household. Agree on a meeting place outside your home where every member of the household will gather to wait for the fire department.
- Check to make sure that your address numbers are still up, not faded, and clearly visible from the street. Replace outdoor light bulbs so address numbers are illuminated at night.
