**Final Property Tax Bills**

The final tax bills for 2019 were mailed this month and will be due in two installments: June 28 and September 30. Past due amounts may be related to outstanding dog tags. For your convenience, please be advised of the following methods of payment available:

- Telephone/internet banking, ABMs (automated bank machines) and at most financial institutions.
  - Pre-authorized payment plans.
  - Mail cheque or money order to P.O. Box 84, Long Sault, ON K0C 1P0.
  - In person at the Town Hall, cash, cheque, debit, post-dated cheque(s).
  - After hours, access the drop off box beside the front entrance of the Town Hall.
- A penalty of 1.25% is added to all outstanding tax accounts the day after the payment due date and continues to be added on the first day of each month until the account is paid in full. Should you have any questions, please contact Town Hall.

**MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT**

**By-Law 2005-60: Pool Safety**

- All fences or attachments must be constructed to a minimum height of 1.5 meters above ground level.
- Wall or building may be considered part of the fence provided it is 1.5 meters in height and any doors within the wall or building must have working locks that are installed 1.5 meters from the ground or adjacent floor or step.
- The pool ladder must not be easily accessible (removed when not in use or protected by a proper gate).
