QUARTERLY WATER/SEWER BILLING

Water consumption has been estimated for October, November and December, 2017. Estimates are based on account history and are due **February 23, 2018**. The next on-site meter reading will be done in March/April. MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT

PARKING AT THE INGLESIDE AND LONG SAULT SHOPPING CENTRES

Section 10.2 of the South Stormont Parking By-law prohibits the parking of vehicles in the Fire Access Route in front of the South Stormont Shopping Centers. Parking is defined as "... the Standing of a Vehicle, whether occupied or not except when Standing temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading merchandise or passengers." This definition does not include waiting for somebody to return from the Post Office, restaurant, bank or store. A common misconception appears to be that as long as the vehicle is not put into "Park", the vehicle is not considered parked. In many cases, those with mobility issues are the ones who make efforts to comply with the By-law; in some cases, while trying to dodge vehicles illegally parked by able bodied people. The set fine is \$50. Please don't park in front of the shopping centres.
