HYDRANT FLUSHING AND MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

Hydrant flushing will be carried out from **April 23-June 1** in the hamlets of Ingleside, Long Sault and St. Andrews West.

- This situation is temporary and may last up to two hours
- The coloured water is not hazardous
- If coloured water is detected, the public is requested to open their COLD water taps in order to clear the system.

ANIMAL CONTROL AND DOGS

- With the nice weather approaching, here are five reasons why you should keep your dog on a leash:
- 1- Setting a good example: As good pet owners, we should keep our dogs on a leash.
 - 2- Protecting your dog: Even if you have control of your dog, you can't control the world around them.
 - 3- Liability: As owners, you are liable for your dog's actions. A leash provides emergency control. Bad things may happen if your dog is running loose.
 - 4- Irresistible Temptations: you can't predict which temptation might be your dog's undoing.
 - 5- It's the LAW: It might not seem like a big deal but the fines for being caught with your dog running at large is \$125.00 and the fee to get your dog back from the Animal Control Officer is \$75.00.

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS WEEK MAY 6-12

Emergency Preparedness Week (EP Week) is an annual event that takes place each year during the first full week of May. If an emergency happens, it may take emergency workers some time to reach you. You should be prepared to take care of yourself and your family for a minimum of 72 hours.

BUILD AN EMERGENCY SURVIVAL KIT TO SURVIVE FOR AT LEAST THREE DAYS

- Bottled water - four litres of water per person per day
- Non-perishable food
- Manual can opener
- Flashlight(s) and extra batteries
- Battery-powered or wind-up radio
- First aid kit
- Special needs items such as medications, infant formula, equipment for people with disabilities, items for pets
- Extra keys to your car and house
- Cash
- Candles and matches/lighter
- A copy of your emergency plan and contact information, important papers (identification, contact list, etc.)

PROPERTY TAX BILLING

The interim tax bills were **due March 29**. A penalty of 1.25% is added to all outstanding tax accounts the day after the payment due date and continues to be added on the first day of each month until the account is paid in full. The Final property tax bill will be mailed in early June.

Pre-authorized Payment Plans are available for property taxes and municipal water/sewer.

Water meters for the first quarter of 2018 have been read and bills will be mailed by the end of April. Should you have any questions concerning your bill, please contact the Town Hall.

DOG TAGS

The 2018 dog licence renewals have been mailed and are due April 27. If not paid by the due date, the licence amount will be transferred to your property tax account and will appear as "past due" on the final taxes. If any information has changed about your dog please contact the Town Hall. Should you no longer have a dog, the tag must be returned to the Town Hall.
