**MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT**

**BY-LAW 2004-86: ABANDONED AND UN-PLATED VEHICLES**

No vehicle in a wrecked, discarded, dismantled, or inoperative condition or that is unlicensed shall be parked, stored, or left in the yard unless such vehicle is required for business or farming purposes, and then only in an arrangement such as to present an unsafe or unsightly condition.

**SMOKE FIRES**

Did you know that careless smoking is the leading cause of fire deaths in Ontario? Here are some tips to avoid careless smoking in your home:

- Encourage smokers to smoke outside.
- Use large, deep ashtrays that can't be knocked over.
- Install smoke alarms on every storey and outside sleeping areas.
- Test your smoke alarms every month and replace the batteries at least once a year.
