- The department issued **7** building permits;

Building-Related Activities:

- Chief Building Official (CBO) attended an Ontario Building Officials Association (OBOA) meeting in Ottawa.
- CBO and planning department staff met with a planning consultant re: redevelopment of a property in Ingleside.
- CBO and planning department staff met with the owner's agents re: existing temporary use by-law for a property in Long Sault.
- CBO attended virtual Provincial Offences Act (POA) court on one occasion.
- CBO and other building department staff met as a group with our HR consultant.
- CBO and by-law department staff attended a site to assess a potentially unsafe building in Lunenburg.
- CBO and planning department staff met with a proponent re: a potential new commercial project in Bonville.

Work In Progress:

- Review and comment on planning application circulations.
- Monthly building permit statistics/information reports provided to MPAC, CMHC, Tarion and Statistics Canada.
- Staff continue to review and action open building permit and open application files. A new focus on this activity is ongoing and staff are having success in closing open files.
- Issue letters with respect to requests from lawyers for outstanding orders and open building permit files.
- Issue letters and invoices with respect to dormant permit files.
- With the release of the new 2024 Ontario Building Code, building department staff are preparing for our upcoming information session on February 5th.
