- The department issued **16** building permits;

## **Building-Related Activities:**

- Chief Building Official (CBO) attended the Ontario Building Officials Association (OBOA) Annual Meeting and Training Sessions (AMTS) conference in London, ON.
- CBO, Director of Planning and Building and finance department staff met to prepare the planning and building department's Skills Development Fund (SDF) grant application.
- CBO and planning department staff held a pre-consultation meeting with the proponent of a development in the Township's East Industrial Park.
- CBO and other Township staff met to discuss the proposed adoption of the new Signs By-law.
- CBO presented a report respecting the proposed adoption of the Signs By-law. The By-law was adopted at the regular meeting of Council on October 9<sup>th</sup>.
- CBO attended Cunningham Swan's annual Municipal Law Seminar at the Township office.
- CBO and other building department staff attended the OBOA's 2024 Ontario Building Code (OBC) roadshow training session in Ottawa.
- CBO, Fire Chief and By-law Enforcement Officer met with a signs provider to review the Township's newly adopted Signs By-law.
- CBO and other Township staff held a pre-consultation meeting with the proponent of a commercial/residential development in Ingleside.
- CBO and other Township staff participated in an emergency management exercise.
- CBO and planning department staff held several days of meetings to review the Township's proposed new Zoning By-law.

## Work In Progress:

- Review and comment on planning application circulations.
- Monthly building permit statistics/information reports provided to MPAC, CMHC, Tarion and Statistics Canada.
- Staff continue to review and action open building permit and open application files. A new focus on this activity is ongoing and staff are having success in closing open files.
- Issue letters with respect to requests from lawyers for outstanding orders and open building permit files.
- Issue letters and invoices with respect to dormant permit files.
