- Chief Building Official (CBO) attended an Ontario Building Officials Association (OBOA) meeting in Morrisburg.
- CBO and other building department staff attended annual health and safety training.
- CBO and planning department staff participated in Bluebeam Revu software training.
- CBO presented during the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing's (MMAH) virtual Municipal Exchange re: South Stormont's Inspector Internship Program.
- CBO and Deputy Chief Building Official (DCBO) attended virtual Provincial Offences Act (POA) court on one occasion.
- CBO attended virtual "Lunch and Learn" webinar re: black ash regulations.
- CBO met with the developer of a proposed self-service storage building in St. Andrews West.
- CBO presented a key information report re: proposed Signs By-law to Council.
- CBO, Director of Planning & Building and finance department staff met to discuss a staffing provincial grant opportunity.
- Enforcement activities:
  - Highway 138 CBO, planning, fire and by-law staff met virtually with legal counsel for owner of a property re: various concerns regarding commercial business currently under operation.
