COUNCIL SUPPORTS CHANGES TO BLUE BOX REGULATIONS FOR INDUSTRIAL, COMMERCIAL AND INSTITUTIONAL PROPERTIES

In 2025, the Province requires producers to fund blue box recycling for residential properties. Industrial, Commercial, and Institutional properties will manage recycling costs themselves.

Council supported a resolution that requests regulations be amended to include collection of Industrial, Commercial, and Institutional properties as well.

REGULATING SIGNS BY-LAW

After extensive public input regarding temporary signage placement in the Township, Council approved By-law 2024-066 to regulate the erection, construction and maintenance of signs.

The new by-law will continue to allow signage in South Stormont, however, location, size, time periods, and insurance requirements will all be considered prior to approval.
